

Potential Maintenance Project

Project: **Complete work on the east parking area**

Project leads:

Description: In 2020 we started a project to clean up and expand the Municipal Reserve east of Lakeview Avenue that is used as a trailer and ice shack parking area.

Work was done in the fall of 2020 and spring of 2021 at a cost of approximately \$30,000. The cost of the project was considerably more than expected. The Hamlet Board decided no more money should be spent until we understood what was needed to complete the work and ensure that the additional cost of the work was approved by the voters of Day's Beach prior to the work being done if the costs were expected to exceed the \$5,000 authority of the Hamlet Board.

Remaining work:

1. Clear trees and debris. – Quote obtained \$2,400 excluding landfill fees
2. Remove topsoil. - someone will do it at no charge
3. Level the ground and prepare it for gravel
4. Purchase and spread gravel

It is expected that the remaining work will cost more than \$5,000 but as we don't have quotes for #3 and #4 we don't know how much it will cost.

Next steps:

1. Poll Day's Beach residents to determine if there is support for this project
2. Send a capital ballot when the cost of the project is known.
